Prof. Aziz Belal

Abdel Aziz Belal is the Chief Executive Officer of Alexandria Ear Hospital and President of the Future Health Society. He served as Dean of Alexandria Medical School and Chairman of Alexandria University Hospitals (2003–2008), overseeing 7,000 students and healthcare for 10 million people.

He managed a 500 million EGP annual healthcare budget and led projects in accreditation, informatics, quality, infection control, insurance, and medical tourism. Aziz trained and practiced at Harvard Medical School and the University of Southern California before joining El Maghraby Hospital, Saudi Arabia.

He has performed ENT surgeries across the Middle East and is regarded as the best ear surgeon in the region. He is the only Middle Eastern surgeon honored with membership in the American Otological Society. He has published over 150 peer-reviewed articles and four books.

He chairs the board of Alexandria Ear Hospital and consults for multiple healthcare and pharmaceutical companies. He earned his M.D. with distinction in 1968 from the University of Alexandria and his Ph.D. from Harvard Medical School in 1975.

Prof. Dr. Badr El Dine is a Professor of Otolaryngology, ENT Department, Faculty of Medicine, Alexandria University, Egypt. His last working position was Senior Consultant in Otology, Neurotology, and Skull Base Surgery at Sultan Qaboos University Hospital, University Medical City, Muscat, Oman (15 December 2020 – 12 December 2024).

Dr. Ravi Ramalingam

Dr. Ravi Ramalingam is the Managing Director of the KKR Group of ENT Hospitals and Clinics in Chennai, India. He heads a group of 20 ENT specialists and allied specialty professionals. The KKR ENT Group runs three ENT hospitals and five peripheral ENT centers in Chennai.

He is the immediate Past President of the Indian Society of Otology, the largest otology association in India with over 2,000 members. He is also a Past President of the Association of Otolaryngologists of India and was its youngest-ever president.

He is a leading cochlear implant surgeon in India, having performed over 3,000 cochlear implantations. He heads the Cochlear Implant team at the KKR Cochlear Implantation Centre.

He primarily practices Middle Ear, Cochlear Implant, and Endoscopic Sinus Surgery and performs the largest number of stapes surgeries in India (about 400 annually), along with hundreds of mastoidectomies and tympanoplasties each year.

Dr. Satish Jain is an innovator, researcher, and surgeon par excellence, and a selfless teacher. He introduced the 360° concept in skull base surgeries using endoscopes and microscopes, widening the horizons for otolaryngologists globally.

He has revolutionized teaching by making surgical videos freely available online. In a short span of his career, he has performed over 150,000 surgeries of the ear, nose, throat, head & neck, and skull base, including advanced tumors removed endoscopically and microscopically.

He is a regular invited chief operating surgeon and trainer worldwide. He innovated several surgical procedures in ENT and initiated Rajasthan's first extensive cochlear implant program in 2004.

He trained extensively in Italy with Mario Sanna, Jacques Magnan, and Paolo Castelnuovo, with over six years of international skull base experience. He has over 150 publications, 40 book chapters, and three textbooks.

He is Founder of the World Skull Base Foundation and Visiting Professor at Shanghai Jiao Tong University. He leads innovations in robotic surgery, VR/AR integration, and global teaching.

He has over 75 publications and has designed and developed 18 ENT instruments, holding multiple design and trademark IPRs. He holds a US patent for EndoHold and an Indian patent for Justtach, with several ongoing patent applications.

He is the founder of Dr. Khan's Creations (innovative ENT instruments) and has trained over 120 ENT surgeons globally through masterclasses and fellowships. He is the author of three medical books and has delivered lectures in 15 countries.

Dr. Sapna Ramkrishna Parab is Consultant at Sushrut and Khan Parab ENT Hospital and Dr. Khan's ENT Research Center and Adjunct Professor of ENT at DY Patil Medical College, Pimpri, Pune. She is a proponent of two-handed endoscopic ENT surgeries.

She has over 75 publications in prestigious journals and is co-developer of patented instruments such as Justtach and EndoHold. She is the Director of Dr. Khan's Creations and ETHENTS.

She has authored three ENT books, three book chapters, holds three trademarks (EEScope, Endofibre, Endomaster), and has been invited faculty at national and international conferences. She was recently awarded "Sanman Stree Shakticha" for her contribution to medicine.

Mads Sølvsten Sørensen is a consultant MD at the Dept. ENT-HNS and Audiology at Rigshospitalet and a clinical professor DMSc of Otolaryngology and Otopathology at the University of Copenhagen, Denmark. He is the head of the Otopathology Laboratory at the Copenhagen Hearing and Balance Center, the author of the Osteodynamic Concept of Otosclerosis, and a former president of the Schuknecht Society at MEEI, Harvard. As teacher of ear surgery, he is the initiator of the Visible Ear Simulator project and research group offering advanced simulation freeware for VR mastoidectomy training and certification worldwide.



Prof Daniele Marchioni
Italy

Prof. Daniele Marchioni is the Full Professor and Chair of the Department of Otolaryngology-Head and Neck Surgery at Policlinico Universitario di Modena since 2021. Prior to this, he served as the department chair and directed the Residency Program at Azienda Ospedaliera Universitaria Integrata di Verona from 2014 to 2021. His previous roles include Attending Physician at Policlinico Universitario di Modena from 2006 to 2014, Consultant at the same institution from 2000 to 2006, and Consultant at Evangelico Valdese Hospital in Torino from 2001 to 2005. He has performed over 10,000 complex surgeries, advancing endoscopic techniques for conditions of the ear, skull base and head & neck. As a founding member of IWGEES, he was instrumental in developing minimally invasive approaches for acoustic neuromas and facial nerve tumors and authored the first international book on endoscopic ear and skull base surgery. He has published more than 200 papers in prestigious scientific journals.

Arun K. Gadre, MD, FACS is board certified in both Otolaryngology- Head Neck Surgery and in Otolaryngology & Neurotology, by the American Board of Otolaryngology. He is currently the Professor of Otolaryngology at the Geisinger Commonwealth School of Medicine, and is the Director of Otolaryngology & Neurotology at Geisinger Medical Center, Danville PA. He has been involved in the education and surgical training of residents and medical students all of his professional life. Dr Gadre has written over 50 peer-reviewed articles and book chapters and received several teaching awards. He has been invited as guest operating faculty for many conferences for middle ear surgery and cochlear implantation.

Alessia Rubini, MD is an ENT Surgeon at the Department of Otorhinolaryngology–Head and Neck Surgery, Modena University Hospital, Italy. She completed her residency at the University of Verona under the mentorship of Professor Daniele Marchioni.

Dr. Rubini has gained advanced training in otosurgery and neurotology through international fellowships and observerships at leading institutions, including the University of Minnesota (USA), University of Toronto (Canada), University of Sydney (Australia), and the Himalayan Institute of Medical Sciences, Dehradun (India).

Her primary interests focus on middle and inner ear surgery and lateral skull base surgery. She has authored several peer-reviewed publications in these fields.

An Executive Board Member of the International Working Group on Endoscopic Ear Surgery, Dr. Rubini is actively involved in surgical education worldwide and regularly serves as course director, instructor, and invited speaker at major temporal bone and endoscopic ear surgery courses and otology conferences.

She is the Clinical Governance and Research Lead at Whipps Cross University Hospital and previously served as Specialty Research Lead for the NIHR North Thames Clinical Research Network. His clinical and research interests include paediatric and adult ENT disorders, balance and vestibular disorders, sudden sensorineural hearing loss, chronic rhinosinusitis, and globus pharyngeus. She has been Principal Investigator and Sub-Investigator in multiple national and international clinical trials and has authored numerous peer-reviewed publications, guidelines, and textbook chapters. Prof. Jumani is an experienced educator and mentor, delivering structured teaching for trainees, medical students, general practitioners, and allied health professionals, and is actively involved in postgraduate training and clinical supervision.

Prof. Vik Veer, FRCS (ORL-HNS) is a Consultant Otolaryngologist at the Royal National Throat, Nose and Ear Hospital (UCL) and Queen's Hospital, London, and a leading international authority in sleep-disordered breathing and sleep surgery. He is a Chief and Principal Investigator in multiple clinical trials and is pioneering novel diagnostic frameworks, patient-reported outcome measures, and digital tools for obstructive sleep apnoea. Prof. Veer has published extensively in high-impact peer-reviewed journals and has contributed to clinical classifications, systematic reviews, and guidelines shaping modern sleep medicine practice. He is the Founder of the British Association of Sleep Surgeons and serves on advisory boards of national and international sleep medicine societies. A globally recognised educator, he has founded and led major ENT training programmes and courses, and is widely known for his academic and digital outreach, with over 25 million views and 200,000 subscribers on his educational platform. He is an invited speaker and faculty member at international conferences, delivering keynotes and live surgical teaching worldwide.

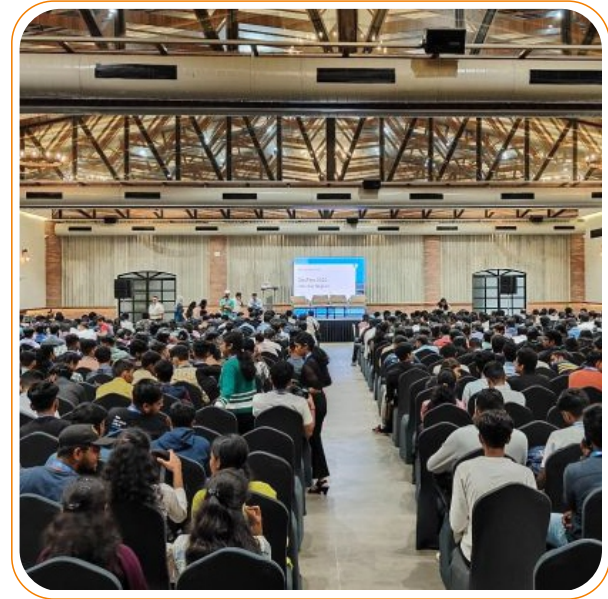
